HAPPY NEW YEAR

We will be switching to remote learning from the 11th January. Every child has a pack to work from. Enjoy completing these at your leisure!

Teachers will put some links and monthly activities onto our nursery page to keep your little ones busy!

This month the children will be encouraged to observe changes in the weather. You may discuss how animals behave in the Winter with a particular focus on birds. Our topic also involves learning about arctic environments. The Artic and Antarctica. You could look at images of these places online with your child or in books/stories.

The children have many opportunities to learn about shapes During play in nursery.

Our shape this month is the circle.

Encourage your child to look around your home and pick out circular shape (e.g. clock). Talk about how the circle shape is "round." How many circular shaped objects can your child find? Make it a game!

Freezing and melting!

We had already begun to talk to the children about how ice is made. You could show your children this, by allowing them to make ice cubes at home. You could then ask them to investigate and find out what happens if the ice if left out of the freezer? Encourage thinking-Why/how does it melt?
